Day 1 SINGAPORE – ZURICH

Assemble at Changi Airport for your flight to **Zurich**, Switzerland's global centre for banking and finance.

Day 2 ZURICH – RHINE FALLS – LUCERNE (Meals on Board)

Upon arrival, embark on your journey with a travel to **Schaffhausen** to view the majestic **Rhine Falls**, the largest waterfall in Western Europe. Continue your journey and enjoy the scenic views of mountains and serene countryside as you proceed to the charming township of **Lucerne**.

Day 3 LUCERNE (Breakfast/Dinner)

After breakfast, start your day with a walking tour to **Chapel Bridge** and the stirring **Lion Monument**, carved from a limestone cliff in memory to the Swiss guards that died defending the French King during the French Revolution in 1792. Thereafter, you may wish to enjoy the rest of the day with a cup of coffee or enjoy your shopping spree for Luxury brands, watches, music boxes, famous Swiss chocolates and more. There's always something for everyone. You may also choose to take an optional excursion to the top of Mt Titlis at your own expense.

Day 4 LUCERNE – TITISEE – HEIDELBERG – RHINELAND (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Today, begin your day with a scenic drive to visit to the largest forest in Germany known as **Black Forest**. Known for its evergreen forests and picturesque villages, and is often associated with the Brothers Grimm fairy tales. Then, adjourn to the tourist resort township of **Titisee**, home to Germany's largest **cuckoo clock centre**, and to one of Germany's most idyllic lakes. Then, travel to the historic region of **Rhineland** via **Heidelberg** for your overnight stay.

Day 5 RHINELAND - COLOGNE - AMSTERDAM (Breakfast/Dinner)

This morning, proceed to **Cologne**, one of the largest and most vibrant cities in Germany. Witness the fascinating old towns in the country, as well as the towering **Cologne Cathedral**. Day 6 AMSTERDAM – BRUSSELS (Breakfast/Dinner)

In the morning, tour **Zaanse Schans**, a quaint Dutch village dotted with well-preserved windmills and cottages. Take the opportunity to visit a **cheese farm** and witness a **wooden clog-making demonstration**. Thereafter, return to Amsterdam to enjoy a refreshing **canal cruise**. Relax on board a glass-domed motor launch cruising down canals flanked by gabled houses. Next, be dazzled by the **diamond house** in Amsterdam and see master craftsmen at work. This evening, continue to beguiling **Brussels**, the capital of Belgium.

Day 7 BRUSSELS - PARIS (Breakfast/Dinner)

After breakfast, your first stop is the magnificent **Atomium**, a marvel of modern architecture, constructed for Expo'58, the 1958 Brussels World's Fair. Drive past **Royal Laeken Palace** before arriving in the city to see the mascot of Brussels, **Manneken Pis**, 16th and 17th-century **Market Square** and resplendent **Grand Place**. Next, travel towards **France** to its capital and showstopper city, **Paris**. Be fascinated by the monumental sights of

Napoleon's Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysees Boulevard and Place de la Concorde on your city tour. Witness the iconic Eiffel Tower and celebrated Notre Dame Cathedral, one of the most magnificent masterpieces of Gothic architecture. Thereafter, visit The Grande Mosquée de Paris ("Great Mosque of Paris"), the largest mosque in France and also the third largest in Europe.
