#### DAY 1 SINGAPORE – DUBAI – RIO DE JANEIRO (Meals On Board/Dinner)

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight via Dubai to **Rio De Janeiro**, famed for Copacabana Beach and Ipanema Beach. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel.

#### DAY 2 RIO DE JANEIRO (Breakfast/Asian Lunch/BBQ Dinner With Brazilian Dance Show)

After breakfast, proceed to **Metropolitan Cathedral of Rio de Janeiro**, known for its pyramidal design symbolising the closeness of people to God. Stroll through the historic **Cinelandia Square** to admire the 3 monumental public buildings: Municipal Chamber, Municipal Theatre of Rio de Janeiro and National Library of Brazil. Next, proceed to **Sugarloaf Mountain** and enjoy a **cable car ride** to its peak, towering 396 metres above the harbour. From the mountain's summit, soak in the expansive views of Guanabara Bay. To cap off your day, indulge in a mouthwatering **BBQ dinner** while being entertained by a captivating **Brazilian dance show**.

#### DAY 3 RIO DE JANEIRO (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

This morning, proceed to **Corcovado Mountain** for a scenic **cogwheel train ride**. Upon reaching the peak, be captivated by the awe-inspiring sight of Christ the Redeemer statue, an iconic symbol not only of Brazil but also of Christianity worldwide. Recognised as one of the new seven wonders of the world, this monument holds immense cultural and historic significance. Thereafter, visit **Laranjeiras**, one of Rio's oldest neighbourhoods. Wander through its charming streets lined with historic buildings and bustling local stores offering fresh produce and unique handicrafts. You will find iconic landmarks like Guanabara Palace, the seat of Rio's state government.

#### Note

Ascent to Corcovado Mountain will be replaced with a van ride, certified by the city administration, if cogwheel train ride is not operating.

#### DAY 4 RIO DE JANEIRO – FOZ DO IGUAZU (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to **Foz de Iguazu**. Upon arrival, head to **Iguazu National Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site nestled on the border between Argentina and Brazil. This national park serves as a sanctuary for the majestic Iguazu Falls on the Brazil side. The Iguazu Falls is a series of individual waterfalls that collectively form the largest waterfall system in the world. While the Brazilian side contributes only about 20% to the entire system, it offers the most breathtaking panoramic views.

#### DAY 5 FOZ DO IGUAZU – PUERTO IGUAZU – FOZ DO IGUAZU (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Start your day by crossing the border to **Puerto Iguazu**, embarking on an exploration of Iguazu Falls on the Argentine side, celebrated as one of the 7 natural wonders of the world. The Devil's Throat, the highest point of Iguazu Falls, towering at an impressive 82 metres, is located at the end of the canyon along the border. Approximately 80% of the falls is located here, offering an array of trails for exploration. Stroll along the river canyon, taking in the diverse flora and fauna that thrive in this lush environment.

#### DAY 6 FOZ DO IGUAZU – SAO PAULO – LIMA (Breakfast/Lunch)

After breakfast, spend the morning at leisure before proceeding to the airport for your flight via Sao Paulo to **Lima**, the capital of Peru. Upon arrival, proceed to check in to the hotel.

#### DAY 7 LIMA (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Start your morning with a leisurely stroll through **Parque del Amor**, affectionately known as Love Park, where you can admire enchanting sculptures celebrating the theme of love. Next, venture to **Huaca Pucllana**, an archaeological site and ceremonial centre designed in the form of an adobe clay pyramid. Next, visit notable landmarks **Plaza de Armas de Lima** and **Cathedral of Lima**, and immerse in the history and culture

of Lima. Thereafter, head to **San Francisco Church and Convent**, a historic colonial masterpiece, and UNESCO World Heritage Site.

**DAY 8 LIMA – CUZCO (Packed Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)**

Today, transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to **Cuzco**. Upon arrival, enjoy a scenic drive to **Chinchoero**, a captivating village nestled in the Sacred Valley of Cuzco. Revered by the Incas as the birthplace of the rainbow, Chinchoero mesmerises visitors with its natural beauty and cultural heritage. Explore the charming streets and discover the historic Church of Our Lady of Montserrat, built in the 17th century. Admire its exquisite Baroque altars and collection of colonial-era paintings.

**Day 9 CUZCO (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner With Folklore Show)**

This morning, embark on an unforgettable journey aboard the **360° Machu Picchu Train**, winding your way through the breathtaking landscapes of the Sacred Valley. Upon arrival, proceed to the renowned **Historic Sanctuary of Machu Picchu**, a true marvel of architecture and history. This iconic site, designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, beckons with its mystical allure and profound cultural legacy. Spanning over 300 square kilometres, Machu Picchu enchants visitors with its diverse array of flora and fauna, as well as its rugged terrain featuring wooded areas, towering mountains and snow-capped peaks. Tonight, enjoy your **dinner with a folklore show**.

**DAY 10 CUZCO (Breakfast/Lunch/Get-Together Dinner)**

After breakfast, embark on a city tour of Cuzco, beginning with a visit to **Plaza de Armas** and **Cathedral Basilica of Cuzco**. Next, immerse in the spiritual heritage of the Incas as you explore **Coricancha**, also known as the Golden Enclosure. This sacred site, dedicated to revered Inca deities such as the creator god Viracocha, the moon mother Mama Quilla and Inti, the god of the sun, offers a profound glimpse into ancient Andean cosmology. Venture into the bustling **San Pedro Market**, a vibrant local market teeming with a kaleidoscope of sights, sounds and aromas. Discover a treasure trove of traditional Peruvian souvenirs, handcrafted goods, fresh produce and more as you wander through its bustling aisles. Thereafter, visit the ancient fortress-temple of **Sacsayhuaman**, marvelling at its monumental stone walls that mimic the natural contours of the surrounding mountain range. Experience the awe-inspiring play of light

and shadow as the sun casts deep triangular shadows across its zigzag terraces. Continue your journey to **Qenqo**, a sacred ritual site where the Incas paid homage to their gods, including the sun, the moon, the earth goddess Pachamama and the mountains. Tonight, enjoy a **get-together dinner**.

This morning, transfer to the airport for your overnight flight home via Lima, Sao Paulo and Dubai.

**Day 11 CUSCO – LA PAZ (Breakfast/Dinner)**

This morning, transfer to the airport for your flight to **La Paz**, the capital of Bolivia. Embark on the city tour of La Paz that includes **Gold Museum** and **Mirador Killi Killi**, one of La Paz's most impressive viewpoints, offering an almost 360-degree view over the city. Thereafter, visit **Witches' Market**, a bustling hub for spiritual practitioners who read fortunes and facilitate offerings to Pachamama.

**Day 12 LA PAZ – UYUNI (Packed Breakfast/Salt Flats Lunch/Dinner)**

This morning, transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to **Uyuni**. Upon arrival, begin your exploration with a visit to the **Train Graveyard**, where you can wander among old rusting train carriages and capture some unique photos. Next, head to **Salar de Uyuni**, a breathtaking natural wonder that spans 10,582 kilometres with a surface covered in salt, visible even from space. You may experience the sight of the world's largest mirror when a thin layer of water transforms the salt flat into a reflection of the sky. Prepare your camera to capture this stunning view as you enjoy a **salt flats lunch**. Thereafter, visit **Isla Incahuasi**, whose name translates to house of the Inca in the native language, emphasising its significance to the Incas. This remarkable island is adorned with a native species of cactus and surrounded by a flat expanse of white hexagonal salt tiles. Revel in the unique landscape before concluding your day with a mesmerising sunset view.

#### Day 13 UYUNI (Breakfast/Picnic Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, head over to the northern side of Salar de Uyuni to view **Tunupa Vocalno**, often covered by lava flows and mudflow deposits. Witness human archaeological specimens hidden in a cave at the base of the Tunupa Volcano, known as Coquesa mummies that are said to be 3000 years old.

#### Day 14 UYUNI – LA PAZ (Packed Breakfast/Bolivian Lunch/Dinner)

Today, transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to La Paz. Upon arrival, take a **Mi Teleferico cable car ride** offering breathtaking views of La Paz from above. Next, explore **Moon Valley**, a mystical wonderland of lunar landscapes and otherworldly geological formations. Let your imagination roam free, imagining yourself on an extraterrestrial adventure.

#### Day 15 LA PAZ – SANTA CRUZ – BUENOS AIRES (Packed Breakfast/Dinner)

This morning, transfer to the airport for your flight via Santa Cruz to **Buenos Aires**, the capital city of Argentina. Upon arrival, begin your city tour starting with the vibrant neighbourhoods of **Recoleta**, **Palermo**, **Plaza de Mayo** and **Casa Rosada**. Marvel at the grandeur of **Metropolitan Cathedral**, explore the trendy **Puerto Madero** area and discover the city's rich history through its unique architectural landmarks and palaces. Thereafter, visit one of the city's oldest neighbourhoods, **San Telmo**, where cobbled streets and a bohemian charm await you. Take a leisure stroll along **Caminito** in the colourful Italian immigrants' neighbourhood of La Boca.

#### Day 16 BUENOS AIRES (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner With Tango Show)

After breakfast, take a **catamaran ride** towards **Costanera Norte**, with the picturesque scenery of San Isidro unfolding along the way. Admire the yacht clubs lining at the Luján River and be mesmerised by the stunning houses and mansions nestled in the ravines offering magnificent views of La Plata. Along the coast, encounter iconic landmarks such as the The Basilica, the Port of Olivos, Estadio Mas Monumental, Universidad de Buenos Aires and witness the constant aerial display of departures and arrivals at Buenos Aires Airport. Tonight, enjoy an entertaining **tango show** with your **dinner**, immersing in the passion and rhythm of this iconic Argentine dance.

#### Day 17 BUENOS AIRES – DUBAI (Breakfast/Meals On Board)

If time permits, you can do some last-minute shopping before you transfer to the airport for your flight home.
