Day 1 SINGAPORE - INCHEON

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Seoul, capital city of South Korea.

Day 2 INCHEON - SEOUL - JEJU (Lunch/Dinner)

Upon arrival, visit the Gyeongbokgung was the first and largest of the royal palaces built during the Joseon Dynasty in the late 14th century and National Folklore Museum of Korea presents historical artifacts that were used in the daily lives of Korean people in the past. Thereafter, transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to Jeju. Upon arrival, proceed to Snoopy Garden, a Snoopy themed indoor and outdoor natural theme park where you can meet the delightful Peanuts characters and an Outdoor Garden, which recreates scenes from the Peanuts comic strip in Jeju's verdant nature. Thereafter, proceed to Rahman Jeju Masjid and end your day with the most famous Nanta Show. A non-verbal performance of free rhythmical movements that dramatize customary Korean percussions in a strikingly comedic stage show, integrating unique Korean traditional drumbeats in a western performance style, turning all kinds of kitchen items - pots, pans, dishes, knives, chopping boards, water bottles, brooms and even each other- into percussion instruments.

Day 3 JEJU (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

This morning, visit Seongsan Sunrise Peak, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that was formed by hydrovolcanic eruption about 5 thousand years ago situated out on the eastern tip of Cheju Island. Next, visit Seongeup Folk Village. An ancient historical village that shows the unique culture of Jeju Island between the 15th century to early 20th century. Well preserved village homes covered with black lava rock walls, the straight but curvy alleys to block the wind. Thereafter, proceed for a hands-on experience of Tangerine picking. Continue to Camellia Hill, seeing various species bloom fully before your eyes in the cold and chilly climate. After which, visit O'Sulloc Green Tea Plantation. It is a must-see spot that fascinates you for a good reason. The O'Sulloc Green Tea Fields Plantation is one of the busier with tourists to Jeju, for a tea-licious reason. The high-quality tea coming straight from the fields of Jeju, the sight and gives your eyes beautiful scenery and a great souvenir from Korea for gift back home. Lastly, visit Jusangjeolli Cliff, spectacular volcanic rock formation at the southern coast of Jeju Island.

Day4 JEJU-SEOUL-CHUNCHEON-PYEONGCHANG (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Transfer for your domestic flight to **Gimpo airport**, Proceed to **Petite France** a cluster of white, exotic buildings resembling a village that belongs on the Mediterranean coast or in a pastoral area of the Piedmont Alps, a French cultural village set in the Korean countryside, and consisting French-style buildings and quaint shops offering French food, clothing, art gallery displaying sculptures and paintings of le coq gaulois (the Gallic rooster), the national symbol of France; Orgel House where a 200-year-old music box plays a sweet melody; a shop that sells herbal and aromatic products; a souvenir shop; and many other locales where you can experience French culture. The filming location for the popular Korean Drama Personal Taste and Secret Garden. Take a boat ride to **Nami Island** the highlight of the island is the birch tree lined path, better known among drama lovers as the path where stars

Day 5 PYEONGCHANG (Breakfast/Dinner)

Next, visit to **Dongdaemun Design Plaza** bearing the hallmark of world-renowned designer Zaha Hadid, be fascinated by its strong curvilinear form that incorporates a museum, business centre and park

Day 7 SEOUL (Breakfast/Lunch/ Dinner)

Today, learn more about Korean culture by participating in making your own **Kimchi** and don in traditional Korean costumes in the **Hanbok dress up** session. Next, visit to **Itaewon Mosque** Seoul Central Mosque, which oversees all Islamic mosques in Korea, and 'Islamic Street,' an area of Itaewon that is becoming established as a special region catering towards those of the Islamic faith. Visit **Korean Cosmetic Shop** one stop focus on promoting a healthy lifestyle offering diverse products ranging from skin care to body and hair care containing natural ingredients. Learn from the experts the techniques and methods for Korean beauty treatments. Not forgetting **Ginseng Showroom**, understand the importance of Ginseng and Red Pine in Korea Culture and tradition. End the day with more shopping spree at **Myeongdong & Hongdae Street**.

Day 8 SEOUL - INCHEON - SINGAPORE (Breakfast/Lunch)
