#### Day 1 SINGAPORE - TAIPEI-YILAN - HUALIEN (Meals on board/Lunch)

Assemble at Changi Airport for your departure flight to Taoyuan International Airport, Taipei. Upon arrival, head to Yilan, on the northeastern coast of Taiwan. Visit **Samsung Onion Experience Farm** for DIY scallion pancakes. Continue to Hualien, located on the east coast of Taiwan on the Pacific Ocean. Next, blast yourself with the **Sky Mirror ATV ride** experience under the guidance of professional instructors. Drift across the sands of Mambo beach and uncover the secrets of Qingshui Cliff. Thereafter, head to **Dongdamen Night Market**, the largest night market in Hualien that integrates various food dishes and famous local shops.

Accommodation: Park City Hotel or similar

# Day 2 Hualien-Taitung (Breakfast/Lunch (Taiwan Seafood)/Dinner (Vegetarian)

This morning, the first stop is at an Aboriginal Specialty Product Center before visiting Taiwan's largest sea-facing rice field, Xinshe Coastal Rice Terraces. Learn and understand how rice grains were being harvested and planted. Next, visit Amis Folk Center, located in the East Coast National Scenic Area to get to know the culture of the indigenous people of the Amis. Continue coach journey to Sanxiantai to admire the beautiful scenery of its coastline. Visit Jialulan Scenic Area, which has incomparable sea views and an excellent photo spot not to be missed. Proceed to Tiehua Cultural Village to learn more about Taitung cultural art.

Accommodation: Kai Shen Starlight Hotel or similar

# DAY 3 TAITUNG (Breakfast/Lunch (Hot Pot)/Dinner)

After breakfast, continue journey to **Brown Avenue**, a pastoral road in **Chishang**, which became popular because of the filming of the Brown Coffee advertisement, and is known as a "green paradise road. Here you can ride a bicycle and enjoy the natural and rural beauty (bicycle fee included). Visit **Kaishan Rice School** and get to know the production and milling process of the best rice in Taiwan. Next, proceed to **Luye High Platform**, with a wide view and beautiful scenery, located at the southern end of the East Rift Valley. Hot air balloon events are held here every July and August. Tonight, enjoy the resort's stay by relaxing in the **hot spring**. **Accommodation: Century Hotel or similar** 

# DAY 4 Taitung-Tainan-Chiayi (Breakfast/Lunch)

Visit **Duoliang Station**, the most beautiful railway station, where the platform turned into an observation deck overlooking the rail track and the Pacific coastline. Next, visit **Ten Drum Cultural Village**, originally a century-old sugar factory. Its miraculous rebirth incorporates the Ten Drum Band's innovative Taiwanese drumming music to give you Asia's first drumming themed international art village. Tonight, continue visit to **Chiayi Wenhua Road Night Market**, a pedestrian area where all kinds of local snacks and delicacies can be sampled. Every day after night falls, vendors offering the newest fashion and a variety of goods.

Accommodation: Mega Hotel Hotel or similar

#### Day5 CHIAYI-NANTOU-CHANGHUA-TAICHUNG (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

This morning, we get to experience **tea culture**, well-known as "Six Sleeps of Tea" in the theme museum, tea garden visit and a guided tour at largest tea production area. Next, visit **Zhongshe Flower Market**, a huge market

and popular photography spot featuring landscaped garden beds with colorful blooms. Proceed to **Taichung Mosque**, built in 1988 and completed in 1990. In the evening, visit **Feng Chia Night Market**, the largest and most popular night market of central Taiwan. It features all kinds of mouthwatering and innovative Taiwanese snacks as well as a shopping paradise for clothings and accessories.

Accommodation: Hotel National or similar





## Day 6 TAICHUNG-TAIPEI (Breakfast/Lunch (Seafood)/Dinner)

Today, seasonal orchard fruit picking experience has been arranged and enjoy fresh taste of the eating! Visit **Yehliu Geopark**, resides within a cape 1.7km long of the northern coast of Taiwan and is home to some of the most famous eroded rock formations in the world. Continue journey to **Jiufen Mountain City**. The movie "Sad City" was filmed in **Jiufen**, an unique old-style architectural style with narrow alleyways of its old town, packed with teahouses, street-food shacks and souvenir shops. Ends your day with visit to vibrant atmosphere of **Ximending**, a popular *shopping* and entertainment *district*.

Accommodation: Caesar Park Hotel or similar

## Day 7 TAIPEI (Breakfast/Lunch (Halal Beef Noodles))

Spend the day exploring the city of Taipei, viewing the **National Palace Museum**. which has a permanent collection of over 677,687 pieces of ancient Chinese artifacts and artworks of over 8,000 years of Chinese history. Proceed to visit **Taipei Grand Mosque**, the largest and most famous, important mosque, an Islamic structure and was registered as a historic landmark on June 26, 1999 by the Taipei City Government in Taiwan. Have some fun with **DIY Handmade Pineapple Tarts** Tonight, **visit Shilin Night Market**, largest and most well-known *night market* in the city, with delicious local snacks and the surrounding businesses and shops selling other nonfood items.

Accommodation: Caesar Park Hotel or similar

### DAY 8 TAIPEI - SINGAPORE (Breakfast/Meal on Board)

If time permits, you can do some last-minute shopping before the transfer to the airport for your flight home.
